

A. GENERAL RULES

1. Effective January 1, 1958, the Omega Psi Phi Fraternity established a membership to be known here and after as "Life Membership," upon payment of an amount prescribed by the Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc.
2. Eligibility: Any financial member of the Fraternity may elect to pay the cost to the Omega Psi Fraternity, Inc. and receive a Life Membership Plaque and a non-expiring national financial card. **Un -financial Members must first become financial before making an application.**

B. RULES GOVERNING PAYMENTS

1. Modes of Payment - The payment for Life Membership may be made in one lump sum or in two equal installments. For instance, the first payment shall accompany the Application for Life Membership (Form 65) and shall represent one-half (50%) of the total amount. The other payment shall be made by the second anniversary of the initial payment. Persons opting to join via the installment plan must pay the annual dues for any fiscal year(s) which occurs prior to final payment being made. Those who fail to make payments by the prescribed deadlines will forfeit any such Life Membership payments made.
2. Format of Payment – All payments shall be in the form of Certified Check or Money Order, shall be accompanied by a signed application, and shall be accompanied by a remittance form (Form 2B). Certified checks or money orders should be made payable to Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. and should be separate from any other type of payment, including annual dues.

C. OTHER CONTINGENCIES/PRIVILEGES/ENTITLEMENTS

1. Entitled to receive a Life Membership Card and a Life Membership Plaque.
2. Entitled to receive Oracles and other official communications/publications of the Fraternity.
3. Entitled to participate in any programs exclusively for Life Membership now in existence or hereafter established, including the Life Membership Foundation. However, no Life Member may vote at meetings of the Foundation, unless he is fully financial (local and district dues paid).
4. Entitled to attend sessions of the Grand Conclave as a visiting brother upon the same terms and conditions applied to other visiting brothers, except that he must be fully financial to run for office. Visiting brothers do not vote.
5. Entitled to be honored by any governance of the Fraternity.
6. Entitled to participate in any local chapter or district activities providing, however, that Life Member fulfills the financial obligations assigned by the respective unit for all of its members.
7. Entitled to receive an annual/current financial card from the International Office, upon notification from the chapter KRS on Form 2B that local and district dues have been remitted for that year.
